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Economically Distressed Areas Program SFY 2023 Annual Report

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Economically Distressed Areas Program Background

For over 30 years, the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB), state officials, and the citizens of Texas have been working together to provide affordable funding for essential basic water and wastewater infrastructure throughout the state. With the development of the Economically Distressed Areas Program (EDAP), in conjunction with other TWDB programs, approximately \$1.25 billion in grants and loans have been made available to fund the planning, acquisition, design, and construction of such projects.

EDAP provides statewide financial assistance in the form of grants and loans to cities, counties, water districts, and nonprofit water supply corporations in economic distress. EDAP projects provide drinking water and wastewater treatment to Texas residents previously without service and improve existing utility systems that do not meet minimum state standards.

In 1989, the 71st Legislature passed comprehensive legislation that established the EDAP and the Model Subdivision Rules (MSR) for the regulation of future residential subdivisions. These laws focused on two major goals: delivering water and wastewater services to meet immediate health and safety concerns and stopping the proliferation of sub-standard subdivisions through the enforcement of development standards.

Throughout its history, the EDAP program has involved collaborative funding with state and federal agencies, such as the Environmental Protection Agency, the United States Department of Agriculture-Rural Development, the Texas Department of Agriculture, North American Development Bank, the Border Environmental Cooperation Commission, and local governments including counties, cities, water and wastewater utilities, and nonprofit groups.

In 2019, the 86th Texas Legislature made changes to the program with the passage of Senate Bill 2452, which directed the TWDB to develop a system for prioritizing EDAP projects and consider projects that will have a "substantial effect." This includes projects serving areas determined to have a nuisance dangerous to public health and safety resulting from water supply and sanitation problems and projects for applicants subject to an enforcement action related to water supply or sewer service violations. The 86th Legislature also passed Senate Joint Resolution 79, later approved by Texas voters as Proposition 2. This constitutional amendment provided the TWDB with "evergreen" bonding authorization, allowing the issuance of general obligation bonds such that the aggregate principal amount of the bonds that are outstanding at any time does not exceed \$200 million.

In 2021, the 87th Texas Legislature appropriated a total of \$6,087,500 in funding for EDAP debt service. This allowed the TWDB to issue up to \$50 million in general obligation bond proceeds each fiscal year (\$100 million over the 2022-2023 biennium). The TWDB developed revised program rules related to prioritization based on Senate Bill 2452, and the most recent solicitation for abridged applications was held from March 14 to May 13, 2022. Abridged applications totaling over \$532 million were submitted for funding consideration.

During State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2023, a total of 18 EDAP commitments were made, amounting to \$86,259,096 in funding allocated to eight projects. All of these commitments are anticipated to close during SFY 2024.

Additionally, during SFY 2023, the 88th Texas Legislature appropriated debt service for \$100,000,000 in EDAP funding during the 2024-2025 biennium.

EDAP Report Updates

Since the previous SFY 2022 report:

- Eight projects received EDAP commitments in SFY 2023, totaling \$86,259,096 in funding.
- One project was completed in SFY 2023.

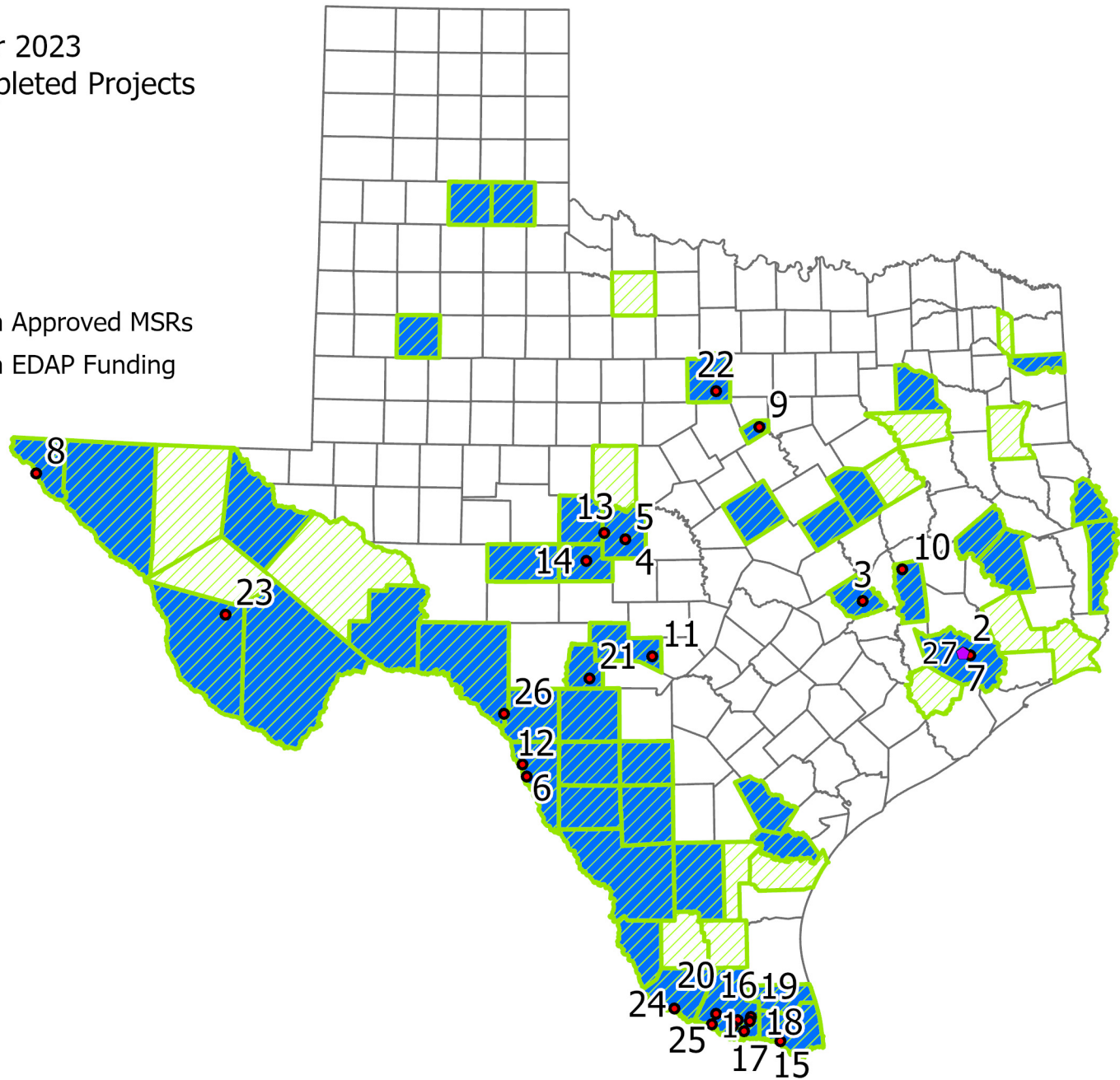
1. "EDAP Population" refers to residents who qualify as Economically Distressed within a relevant subdivision.
