

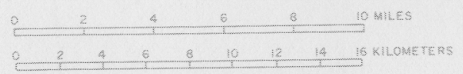


EXPLANATION

 **WELL USED FOR CONTROL**--Upper number is depth to water below land surface, in feet. Lower number is altitude of water level. (r indicates reported; e indicates estimated).

 **WATER-LEVEL CONTOUR**--Shows altitude at which water level would have stood in tightly cased wells. Dashed where approximately located. Contour intervals 20 and 100 feet. (6 and 30m). Datum is National Geodetic Vertical Datum (mean sea level)
